Leighton Buzzard 3b 1794 Girl making lace/A Lamb. Red in devices, a tad of rub on the lamb and considerable original luster, though subdued. **RR** variety, very seldom seen, AU+ \$175.

AYLESBURY 3. 1796 Justice Seated/Arms. Luster, nice obv, bit of roughness rev, UNC \$125.
Another, this with a small spot at rim on obv, reverse nice. Otherwise UNC, \$125.

AYLESBURY 7. 1796 Wm. III/Liberty pole, flags. These from sunken dies, the centers weak on both sides as is normal. Anti Slavery sentiment, very early for such, Ch AU, some red, \$145.

CHESHAM 20. 1795 Lion over castle/Arms. GVF \$32. Minor mks UNC, net EF \$45.

SLOUGH 23 1794 Wm Till, family arms/Red Lion Inn, Full luster super surf UNC \$235

This was issued by Pinkerton when his "navvies" were digging the Basingstoke Canal, and used as payment for the workers---which explains the number seen in low grade, and the difficulty in finding a nice one. These often are a tad weak on the wheelbarrow, this one however has a tad of rub over all, but with near perfect surfaces, looks UNC, nets AU, and is certainly RARE when nice, price \$625.
EMSWORTH	13	1794	Bust Earl Howe/Britannia. Some red, some luster. GEF-UNC \$65.
EMSWORTH	23	1795	Earl Howe/Rule Britannia. Fading red to brown, nice UNC \$110.

LIVERPOOL 66 1791 Ship/Arms of Liverpool,. Nice AU \$95.

YOUNG'S 39 1794 St. Paul's/Star and Garter. EF, full date, very nice piece \$45.

NATIONAL 176 1789 George III/St Paul's &c. Choice VF, rare copper, \$95.

NATIONAL 182 1789 George III/Crown, harp, sun and rays. What appears to be bronzed white metal, some minor mks, and the bronzing flaking off the edges in places. The flan pebbly.

Probably about as made, but has the look of a GVF. This piece lists **RRR**, and is, I am sure. \$195.

NATIONAL 186 (1788) William III/ George III. WM. AU, small mks in field, price EF \$95.

POL-SOCIAL 223 ND Bust Fox/Poem. UNC, nicely lacquered, glossy, net AU+ \$155.

Christ's Hospital 278 1800 Cypher "CH"/Halfpenny. EF, some red, \$65. AU \$95.

CHING'S 282 ND Bust Ching/Arms. Quack medicine, dark flan, nice AU-UNC, \$65.

DAVIDSON'S` 295 1795 Female seated, sword/Hands holding triangle. AU \$45, AU++\$55.

Medals, and other things were made in his honor, including a **handkerchief with his portrait** on it. This one, thankfully unused, and as new, \$45. Essentially unknown, a few were found in 2012.

Execution of the King of France---by Kuchler, Soho mint. 48mm--1795.
