There are a very few of these impounded in museums, and **W. J. Davis**, who struck a copy Workhouse Sixpence, and catalogued the 19th C tokens in the late 1890's, managed to find a few of them. All of the existing examples are unissued. They were made, according to Davis, in around 1808 (between the Conder series and the 19th C token issues). These notes were released by the Davis family. Each contain the name or the shield of the workhouse, and other information. They are dated 180--. **All so rare that most, including me, did not know they existed.** This is a great collectable, no hoards known, and a good opportunity for the Workhouse token collector or note collector. Each is one of two known in commerce.

Five Shillings----Birmingham Workhouse, 180--. "The Overseers of the poor will pay the bearer"---Larger in size--- 3 and 7/8 by 2 7/8 inches. Two crease marks, otherwise **Extremely fine, Ext. Rare.** \$245

AUTOGRAPH OF GEORGE III--- A partial document, 3.2" by 7.75", signed by the King during one of the wars with France, possibly during the American Revolution--- the document giving authorization to "Messrs G. and J. Van Keck & Co" to do business despite restrictions placed on doing business with allies of France. Choice wax and paper Royal Seal. Minor wear, but overall for a paper item VG. Most signatures of George III, if on a good full document, now to \$1500. Wonderful for display, **this piece just \$350.**

Booklet, The Royal Rumping----featuring a dandy looking at the Rump of what looks like George IV, and am sure it is supposed to be---24 pages, published Ludgate Hill, 1821. Dublin Zoo----WM (pewter?) 31mm, 1844---pictorial of a **Giraffe**, born in London and presented to the Dublin Zoo---/Formation of the Dublin Zoological Society. AEF, nice piece, \$155.

USA Confederate bond slip, small payment ticket for an 1864 Civil War confederate bond that when presented would pay the bondholder 30 dollars for six months interest in 1874. \$5 !!!

Continental Currency Dollars--- these were done by Robert Bashlow in 1961, using the dies of Dickenson done for the centennial in 1876. Copper, \$45. White metal, in plastic holder, \$75. All as new.

Sports---- **Sports on board** medal for the ship, RMS Carisbrook Castle. Steam with sails, circa 1880-90.. Copper, superb EF or perhaps better, 39mm. View of steam ship obverse/Reverse with sailing ship. \$88.
