Calendar medal---copper, 1959. Kentish Horse/a calendar for 1959. Presented by the Kent Messenger, newspaper in Kent. A few small edge tics, otherwise in good condition, net VF or better, \$42.

Kings and Queens of England, A 44mm WM medal, toned, a Crown on the obverse and each side containing information on each King and Queen to Victoria from the battle of Hastings. VF+ nice \$48.

Prince of Wales, Princess Alexandra (Future Edward VII), 50mm WM medal, about EF, toned but very nice looking and no peasting, Bust R/Prince's feathers, information. Marriage, 1863. Nice medal, \$45.
