A big hello to all. Very packed Spring, the Summer really busy too. Started out with a broken furnace—(still broken), a stove, that was repaired after nearly a month had passed without one, and a computer that decided to shut off by itself, letting me know there was certainly something WRONG!! So, three weeks without a computer, I am back to work. Really late getting started--, but back to work. As the newest list is supposed to be out in a few days, I had best start now!! My relatively newfound health condition finds me very tired much of the time, cannot seem to burn the midnight oil like I used to. Guess that's life----

Some have finished things up nicely, Jon Lusk has a new book, and by this time I will have sent the information to all. It not only replaces Bell's "Commercial Coins", but flies far beyond it, making corrections and finding new sources as he went, and adding the number of tokens in that category by a bunch. Wonderful book, see the book section on how to order it if you have not received my information sheet via E-mail. The rest of the Bell books are safe for now, but this volume far surpasses Bell's first effort. You will love it.

The new D&H is very slowly coming into focus, thanks to everyone that contributed to the addenda, and all the help I had in making as sure as I can that it is correct. Lots of entries. Also in the works are pages that will help the owner use the book, especially new owners, and the cost will be kept as low as possible for the volume. At the moment, it seems that it will not be completed and ready for printing until winter, the earliest I can see it coming on the market is around the first of 2015. I have not been taking orders for it, but will with the winter list in November. By then, will have a better handle on the date it will be done.

Coming up for Fall, two auctions that contain tokens are scheduled. The first one up will be Baldwin's, on 30 September. It is hard to know just what is to be offered at this point in time, but it is understood that around four token auctions could be held, and what might be in the first one could be part one, or it could be a run of everything else they have. We shall see. It has also been reported that the tokens that will hit the light of day are not going to be cleaned or handled in any way, but left as they are after around 100 years of storage. This means that personal inspection, to get under many years of sitting, will be quite important. The second auction, to be held 1 October, the next day, will be at DNW, and will have the remainder of the Griffiths sale, other properties, and as I have been told, mostly 17th C tokens and other things. Not a lot of other 18th century pieces, but that might change in the next month too, just reporting what it looks like now.

As to this sale, there are the usual run of decent to gemmy common tokens, as well as some sought after rarities and condition rarities. Also, some very rare pieces with some wear that will be perfect for the budget minded, and the usual runs of other series, 17th, 19th, Unofficial farthings, and a few silver tokens, to go along with a couple fun stuff pages.

Earl Howe---18th Century (Conder) tokens often portray Earl Howe, with "the Glorious First of June" as a legend. He defeated the French 1 June 1794, with ships taken, This medal is copper, 1799, by T. Wyon, bust to left, column and naval trophies. EF, but with a few obv. spots. Nice color. BHM 468. \$145.

Capture of Ghent//AE, 31mm by Mauer. King Ludovicus// City goddess mourns, lion, &c. 1678 Proof \$145.

Monneron, French Republic. Hercules Rowing//Parymid. Value 5 Sols, a gilt example, from year 1 (1792) Edge bump (small), and a few handling mks, but fully gilt, Net EF. Nice piece, \$135.

Peace of Amiens---Bust Cornwallis//Britannia, with plaque of George III &c. 1802, 38mm. White metal, this piece is UNC and has no pecking or problems, and lots of original luster!! Very choice example \$145.

Mudie Medals---made for Mudie's series of National Medals for the Napoleonic wars in 1820. All are 41mm.

Dedication Medal--George III//Religion Seated. Choice UNC, bronzed, \$175. BHM 1057, medal #1.

Peace to the world---Prince Regent//Britannia extends laurel branch. GEF, luster, \$145. BHM 1057 medal #28.

Allan Wyon---AE, 45mm, Bust to Left//In memory, &c. 1907, Gem UNC. \$145. Last of the Wyon die sinkers.

Benjamin Franklin, Antoine Monton. 42mm BZ, 1833. Issued by a French society to keep the memory of famous persons who benefited Humanity. This piece about new, Bust L//legends. Super example \$145.

Jubilee of the Great Exhibition (Crystal Palace). WM, busts of young Victoria, Albert//Busts of Edward VII and Alexandra. 1851, 1901. AEF, 28mm and not seen too often, \$55.

Duke of Northumberland---40mm Bz, Bust R//Column erected in his honor 1816. EF, nice \$72.

Duke of Cumberland---This medal fully gilt, 31mm, and 1746. For the Battle of Culloden, where Prince Charlie met the duke of Cumberland, and was defeated by him. Obv, The Duke of Cumberland, Reverse, Prince Charlie kneels in front of a rampant lion. Softly struck---typical for the era---At least EF, \$110.

Louisiana Purchase Medal---Busts of Jefferson and Napoleon//Map of the United States. 1904, made for distribution at the 1904 St. Louis Expo and Fair. This example with some golden toning, and somewhat prooflike. Minimum of disturbance, easily UNC and worth \$250.

Exploration---some great medals remembering some of the most important world explorers, reasonable cost---

All of these medals are anniversary pieces, 500 years, and more, most made 1960-1970.

Pedro Alvarez Cabral---Bz, 79mm/ Bust Cabral//Explorers raise his column on foreign shores. AU \$45.

Henry the Navigator. 1434-1460---Bust L/ Map of world exploration. 79mm bz, super medal. UNC \$55.

Another, 51mm, 1894, 500th Anniversary. Bust, with large sea hat..Crown over arms. GEF, nice \$45.

Magellan. 60mm Bz, neat piece, Bust facing//Ship approaching the "edge" of the known world. Struck by the Saint Petersburg Mint. Leaves nothing to the imagination. These fellows were heros---UNC \$55.

Joao Gonsalves Zarco. Portugal, the Madeira exploration. **SILVER---70grams.** Bust to left, very well done, Legends on Portuguese exploration and Madeira voyage. As made, in 2001, \$75.
