Hello to all---If you are reading this list, I have made it back from the UK. An interesting trip, but more about that in future issues. As most know, the production of Dalton and Hamer's book halted a few years back, and every seller I know of has none left. Thus, I started thinking about producing a new volume. It has been in the planning stage for some time, with me rather waffling back and forth as to whether to print these when the digital age is upon us. I have decided to do it. The material will be placed in the hands of Thomas Publications to be herded through the printing process, and quality will be checked out before we really go to press with it. I have a partner in this, Dean Thomas who runs Thomas Publications, to keep everything on an even keel during printing.

The book will look like the ones done by Davisson and his predecessors, it will be a direct copy of the 1910-1917 Dalton and Hamer effort. This edition is planned to have a complete addenda in the front, in alphabetical order by county, and eliminate the pieces and parts and pockets. The original addenda will be included only as a look at what they had. There will also be an introduction that will have information on words, rarity, and other things not covered before to any degree.

What is needed is YOU---to send me information on what you might have in new finds---new tokens, new mules, new edges, new metals for any given piece, and anything else that comes to mind. All new information will be double checked, and included in the new addenda.

All of this will take some time to compile and to get to the printer. It is always, it seems, later than sooner, so the book will not be along tomorrow. And, it cannot be printed until the collectors weigh in with suggestions, what is needed, etc, along with the material to add into the addenda section.

We are looking forward to being able to offer this book at a good deal less than it has been previously offered. We think that it will promote sales to be a bit more inexpensive, and that the additional information, and hopefully the great plates---will sell some of them.

I will happily open the door for pre-orders, though price is not yet determined. Delivery will be well down the line, so you can order based on how you feel right now, not later. It will be well into 2014 before we see any of them. It took me some time to talk myself into taking this on---please help us get started, your new finds, your comments, all needed.

Many thanks for all, this is going to be exciting to do. Enjoy the list, Bill
